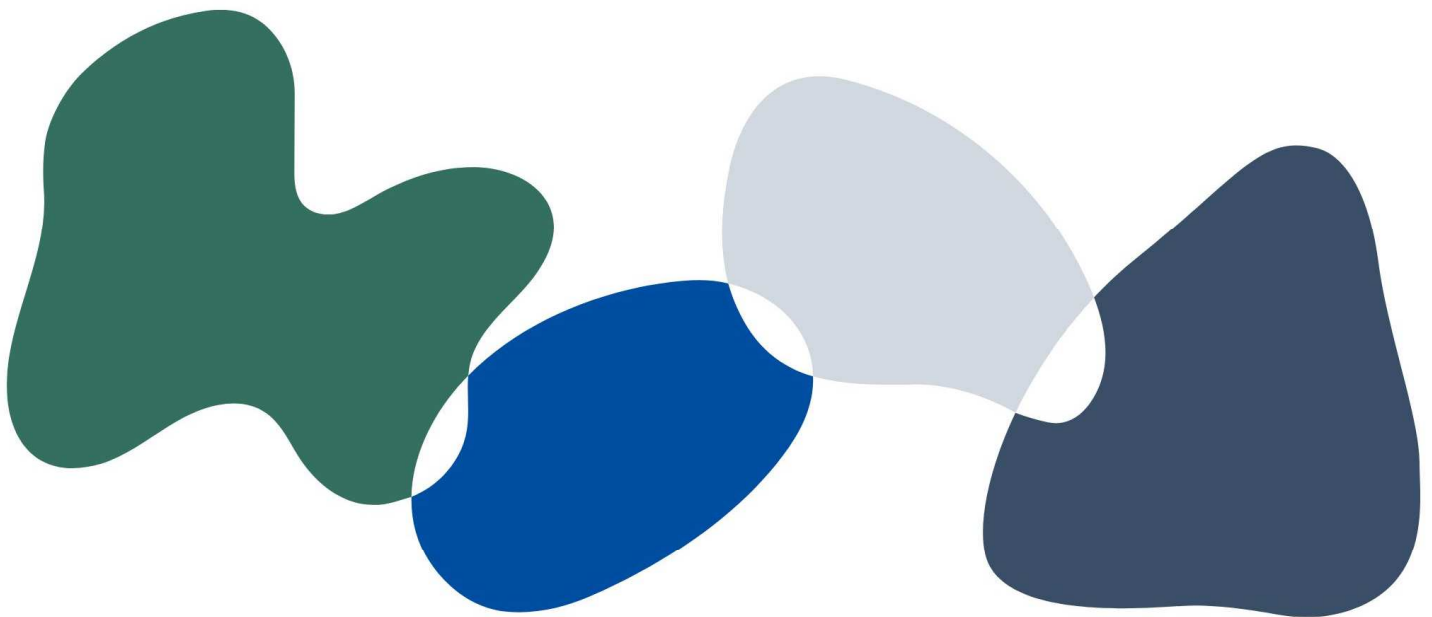

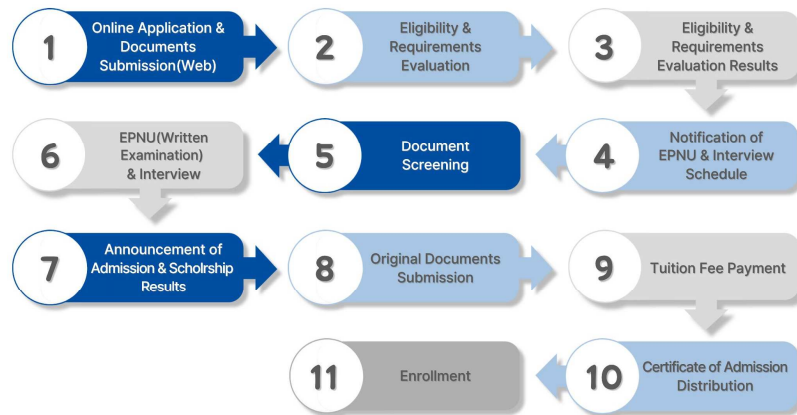

4. Qualifications

A. Eligibility

1) **Both the applicant and the parents must be foreign nationals.**

- Korean and dual nationals are not eligible to apply.
- If the applicant and the parents acquired foreign nationality through emigration or adoption, their acquisition must have been completed before the applicant started the curricula equivalent to Korea's elementary and secondary education in a foreign country (the proof of nationality acquisition is required.)

2) **Applicants must submit a recommendation letter.**

- A recommendation letter from a teacher or the principal of the high school from which the applicant graduated (or is expected to graduate).

- All documents should be original copies. If documents are not written in Korean or English, they should be translated into either Korean or English and notarized.

[Reference 1] Transcripts of High School and Certificate of (Expected) High School Graduation

- Transcripts should have information on C.G.P.A (GPA for **each grade** and **total average for 3 years' GPA**). If not available, applicant must submit an additional official certificate issued by the high school, confirming that the applicant's academic achievement meets the requirement.
- Admitted applicants must submit the documents with authentication issued **by Korean Embassy or Consulate** by June 26, 2026
*** Only documents issued within 6 months of the application deadline (April 19, 2026) will be accepted.**

[Reference 2] Certificate of Language Proficiency

- The certificate is valid only if the result was **obtained after April 13, 2024**. Please upload the scanned copy on the application website (www.studyinkorea.go.kr)
- If you obtain a higher score after completing the online application, please submit the final result to gopnu@pusan.ac.kr by the date of the Entrance Interview.
- Submitting both Korean and English proficiency certificates may earn extra points during the PNU Entrance Exam

[Reference 3] Proof of Financial Capability Documents

- Only admitted applicants who are **not scholarship recipients** need to submit this.
- A bank balance certificate showing a deposit of at least KRW 16,000,000 under the applicant's or their parent's name, along with the Certificate of Financial Support, must be submitted by June 26, 2026

7. Selection Criteria and Admission Process

- 1) Format: Multiple-choice (including short-answer questions), in English.
- 2) Number of Questions: Approximately 10 (subject to adjustment based on difficulty).
- 3) Exam Duration: Around 1 hour
- 4) Important Notes: Applicants must submit both answers and solution processes. Partial credit may be given based on the solution process.

B. Interview (50 points)

- 1) Duration: 5 to 10 minutes per applicant (in English or Korean)
- 2) Evaluation Criteria: Academic ability, personal qualities, and academic attitude, review of personal statement and study plan
 - High school proficiency and background (courses and grades)
 - Language proficiency – English and Korean (including official English test scores and TOPIK)
 - * Applicant who have both English and Korean proficiency will get extra points.
 - Academic reference materials submitted by the applicant (e.g., SAT scores, university entrance exam results, Olympiad awards, etc.)
 - Assessment of the personal statement and study plan
- 3) Interview Guidelines
 - Applicants must bring a valid ID on the interview day.
 - Any misconduct, such as proxy interviews or submission of false documents, will result in disqualification, even if admission has already been granted. If discovered after enrollment, admission will be revoked.

8. Application Fee: KRW 144,000 * Application fee is no-refundable

- A. Payment upon application.
- B. Applicants who do not pay the fee will not be allowed to participate in the entrance exam.

9. Announcement of Final Admission Decision

A. Announcement of Admission Results

- 1) Date and Time: **June 5 2026 (Fri), 16:00 (tentative)**
- 2) Location: PNU admission website (<http://go.pusan.ac.kr>) and individual notification (via personal email)
- 3) Important Notes:
 - The admitted applicants must check and familiarize themselves with the Admission Notice and guidelines on the PNU admission website, and comply with all requirements to avoid penalties and admission cancellation.
 - Scholarship recipients must notify PNU International (gopnu@pusan.ac.kr) ***by June 12 2026, 12:00 pm*** if they decide to forgo enrollment.
 - Non-scholarship students must pay the tuition fees within the designated period and submit the **Proof of financial capability documents *by June 26, 2026.***

B. Registration

- 1) Date and Time: **June 24 (Wed) ~ 26 (Fri) 2026 (tentative)**
 - Applicants will have their admission canceled if they do not pay the tuition fees.

10. Important Notes

- A. **Applicants who are absent from the interview and the written examination will be considered as disqualified.**
- B. Submitted documents will not be returned and application fees are non-refundable. **The applicants can't change the department and major.**
- C. During the application and admission periods, all notifications will be announced on the admission website and individual emails.
- D. Any disadvantages (including cancellation of admission) due to missing documents, errors or omissions in the application, failure to meet requirements outlined in the admissions guide, unclear address, failure to respond to communication, failure to check the admission results, or non-compliance with subsequent procedures, etc., will be the responsibility of the applicant.
- E. **If the applicant gains admission illegally, such as through forgery or alteration of documents or translation errors of documents, admission will be cancelled and if the applicant has graduated, their academic credentials will be annulled.**
- F. Applicants who have Korean name should submit documents proving their name. (e.g., transcript, diploma, official domestic documents such as marriage registration or naturalization approval notice) Korean names listed in notarized documents will not be accepted.
- G. Certificate of Admission will be sent to the email address provided in the application.
- H. The final admitted applicants must obtain the Certificate of Admission from the PNU International and apply for a student visa at the Korean embassy (or consulate) in their home country, or change their visa at the local immigration office.
- I. **Admitted applicants must carefully review the admissions guidelines for visa, dormitory, insurance, course registration, and tuition payment instructions. The guidelines will be available on the admission website upon announcement of the results and will also be sent via individual email.**
- J. All international students must enroll in insurance designated or recommended by Pusan National University or submit their own insurance certificate. If not enrolled, the candidate will bear any resulting disadvantages. It's is required for dormitory and class registration.
- K. Any matters not specified in the guidelines will follows the regulations of Pusan Nation University. For more information, refer to the admission website or contact the PNU International.
- L. Applicants should note that if they fail to earn the required credits or meet graduation requirements according to university regulations, they may not be able to graduate within the standard period.
